



HIGHLANDS RANCH COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

2022 Program Guidelines

The Highlands Ranch Community Scholarship Fund is a 501(c)3 organization providing post-secondary education scholarships for students either residing in Highlands Ranch and graduating high school in 2022, or students attending a Highlands Ranch high school graduating in 2022.

The scholarship rewards students who have demonstrated well-rounded participation in their community or school through volunteerism and/or community service hours.

- Scholarships are \$2500 each for the selected recipients.
- Awards are granted on an equal opportunity basis.
- Review of applications and all scholarship decisions are made by the Highlands Ranch Community Scholarship Fund Committee and approved by the Board of Directors.
- Applicants must be dependent children entering school in the summer or fall in the year the scholarship was awarded.
- Applicants must be students who are enrolled in a full-time course of study at an accredited institution or vocational-technical school.
- Awards are determined by:
 - ✓ Mentoring Experience
 - ✓ Community/Volunteer Service Experience
 - ✓ Job/Work Experience
 - ✓ Activities/Extra-Curricular & School Participation
 - ✓ Brief Statement describing how participation in Community Service has impacted your life
 - ✓ Short Essay on your future educational and career objectives
 - ✓ Current Transcript including grades for first semester senior year
 - ✓ Three (3) letters of recommendations (from teachers, employers, coaches, volunteer organizations, etc.)
- Applicants are responsible for submitting a complete application.
- The application packet must be received in person on or before 5 p.m. on **Tuesday, March 1, 2022**, or postmarked no later than **March 1, 2022**. The address for drop off or mailing is: Highlands Ranch Community Association, 9568 University Blvd., Highlands Ranch, Colorado 80126.
